GCS-VD CLINIC

In their continuing efforts to assist the Gay Community, Norman, who heads the Tucson Gay Community Services announces that, beginning December 8th and once a month thereafter, they will sponsor a V.D. prevention program to be held at the Free Clinic of Tucson which is located at the corner of W. Franklin and Granada downtown. Several GCS members are taking classes in blood sampling and smears, which means that you will not have to go to a non-gay doctor to have this done if you are sensitive. You will be contacted by GCS if the test proves positive and treatment can begin with one of three options: (1) Pima County Health Department, which is free; (2) Your own physician; or (3) Tucson Free Clinic which will ask for a donation to cover the medicines used.

If you are sexually active, we implore you to take advantage of this free test frequently to prevent the escalation of this easily cured but easily communicable disease.

We congratulate Gay Community Services for this action and only hope that members of our community will take advantage of this free service. For any further details, call

On response to a question about the activities in and around Himmel Park, we have had to go to our computer for some response and, unfortunately, the park area is part of what we call a grid which includes homes and businesses in the same area, so the figures might be inaccurate as far as pertaining to the Gay Community.

In the month of August there were a total of 31 offenses reported which resulted in 14 arrests. In the month of September 20 offenses resulted in 10 arrests. The two month total being 51 offenses that were reported and 24 arrests being made.

We are sorry that a more detailed report cannot be made that would include Himmel Park only, but such a narrow breakdown is not available in our computer system, and the time consumed going over every report for the two month period would be too time consuming. We hope that this will give you an idea of the activity in this entire area, and we caution you about muggers and robbers who do frequent the park.
